Pines also manages the Salvation Army Motel Fund. This fund provides up to 7 days stay in a designated hotel for individuals who are homeless that meet the grant criteria. Homeless means sleeping in a place not meant for human habitation.

For most individuals, securing a place to sleep, shelter for their children, and food to eat are a number one priority! We want to assist you as we are able to meet these very basic needs, so that you may then start looking at your other needs. Things such as income, medical care, and transportation.

All money used to provide housing services come from State and Federal programs and grants. These programs have strict criteria that govern eligibility for housing and other services.
